- North Yorkshire Police is committed to transparency in the exercise of its powers to Stop & Search
- This document provides a rolling 12 month overview of the use of our powers to Stop & Search
- The data provides an overview on:
 - Reasons to carry out Stop & Search
 - Use of Stop & Search on residents and non-residents of North Yorkshire
 - Use of Stop & Search on members of our community with Asian, Black or Mixed ethnicity heritage
 - Use of Stop & Search at a District level
- It is worth noting that the numbers for Stop & Search are low in North Yorkshire and a small variation in actual recorded stops can lead to a significant variation in the overall percentages presented

- The greatest numbers of Stop & Search took place in the evening economy on a Friday and Saturday.

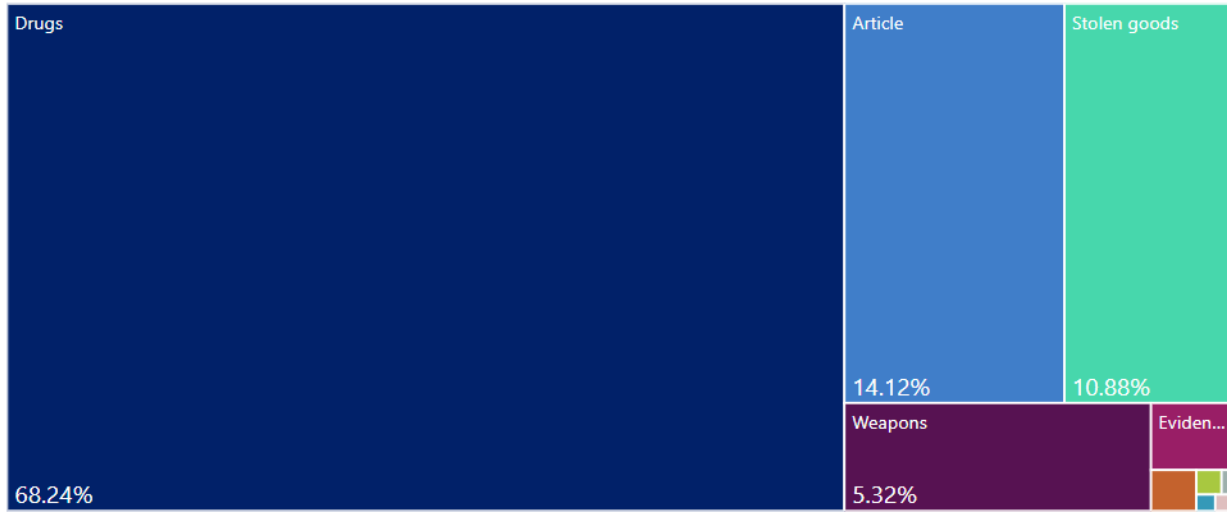
Reasons recorded for Stop & Search powers being used

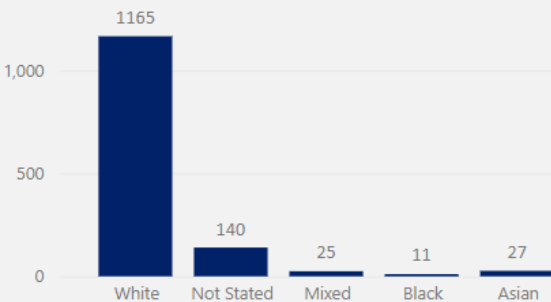

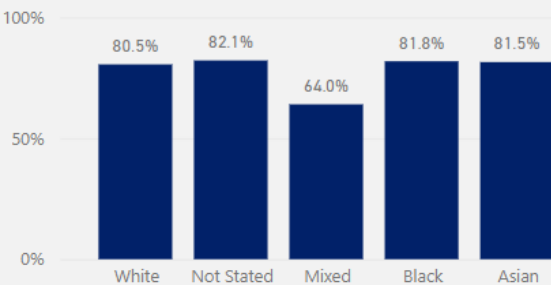

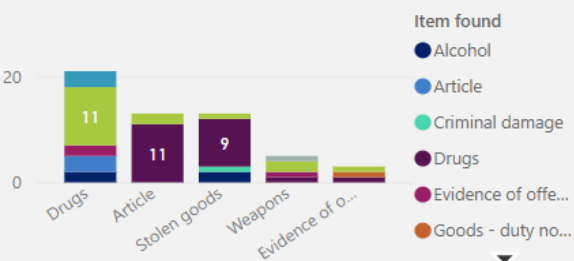

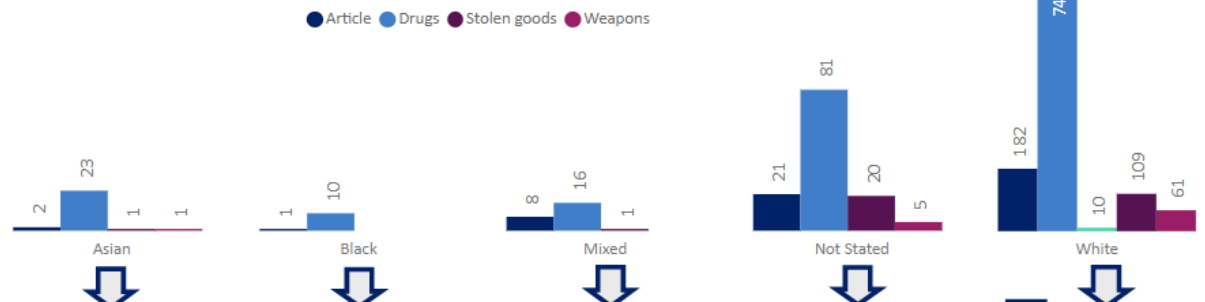
% of no further action taken after search by ethnicity



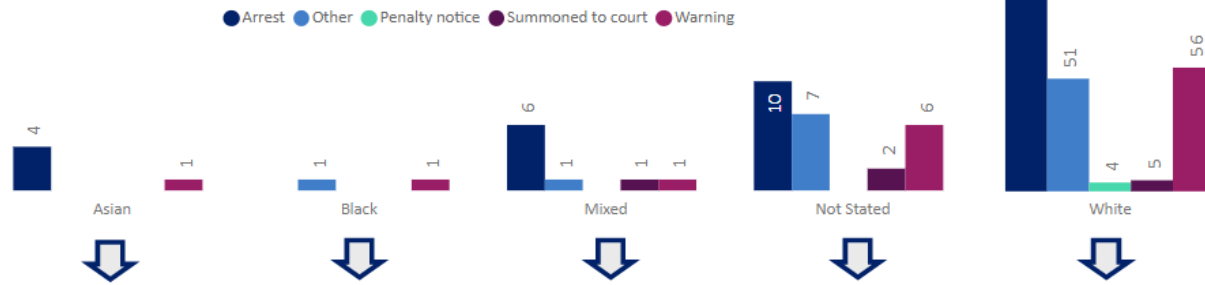

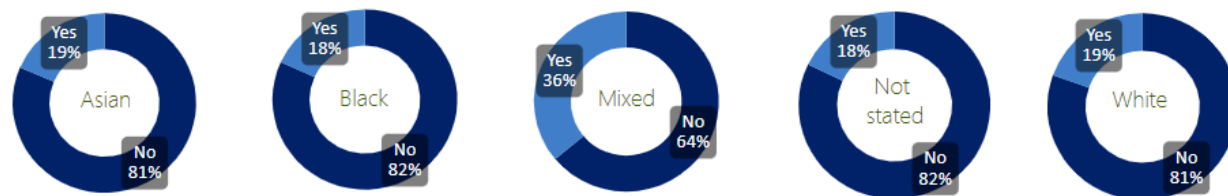
Stop reason

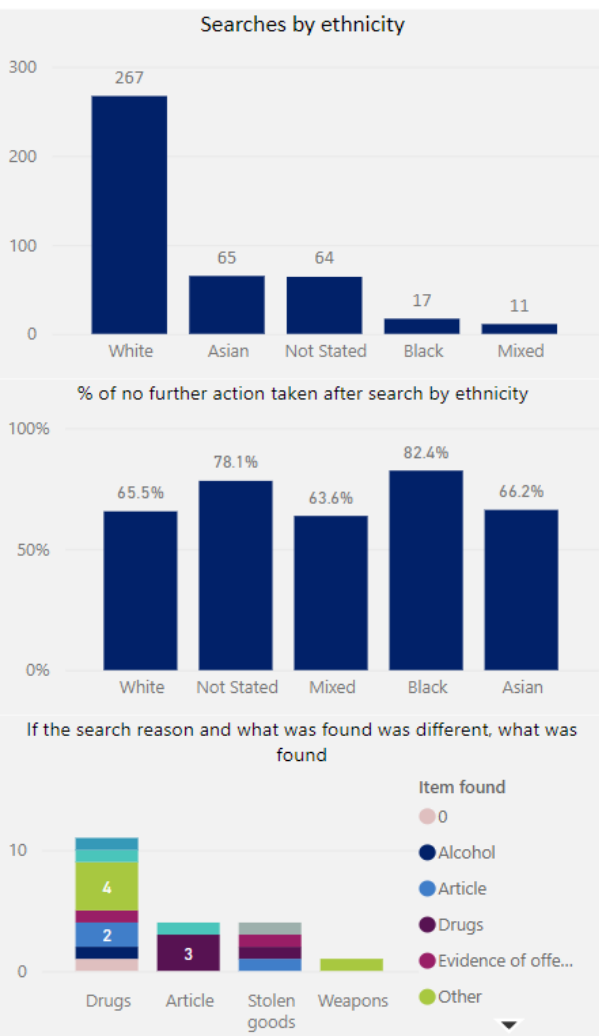

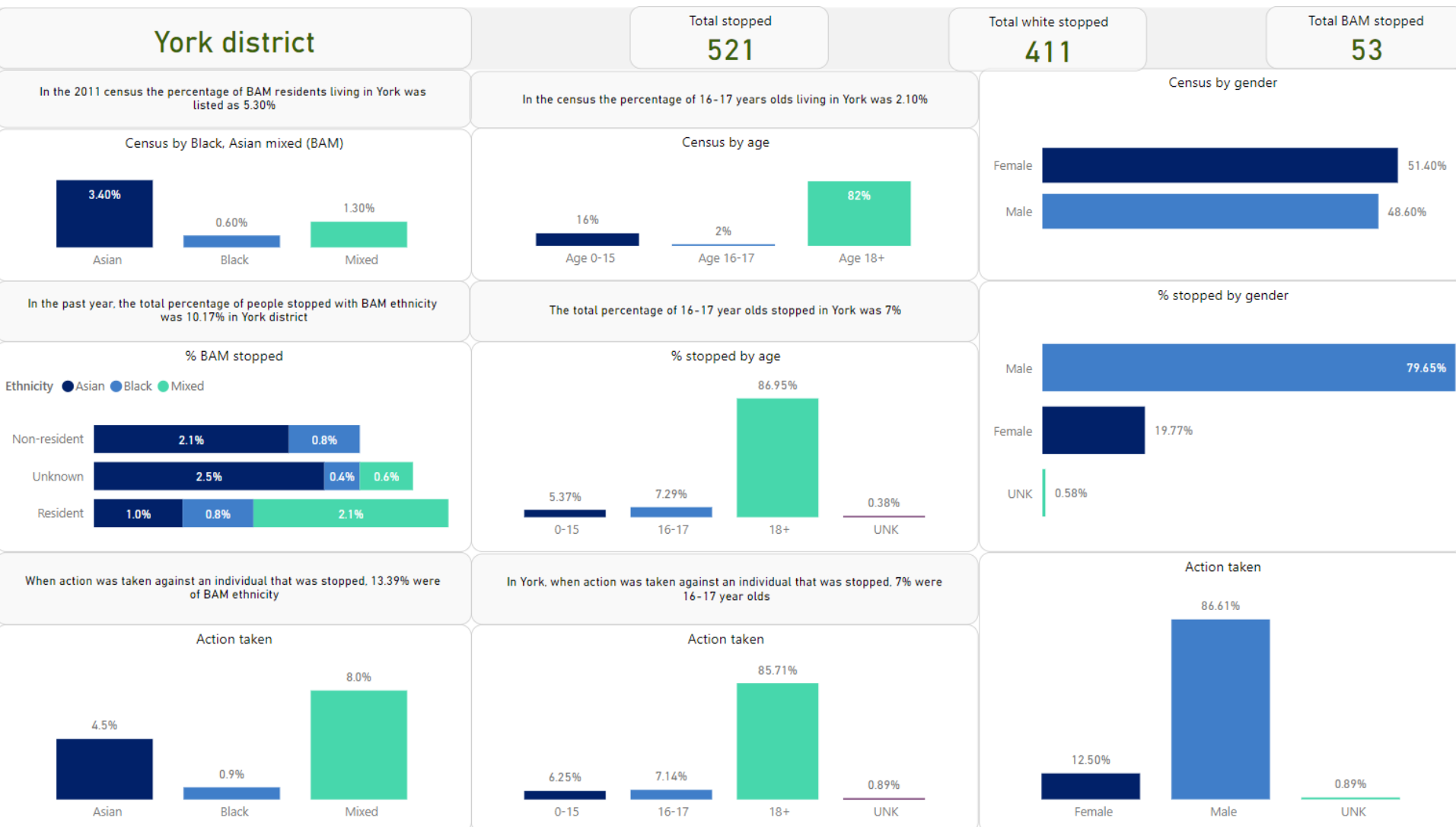


Use of Stop and Search powers throughout North Yorkshire. Detailing when powers were used on non-residents of North Yorkshire



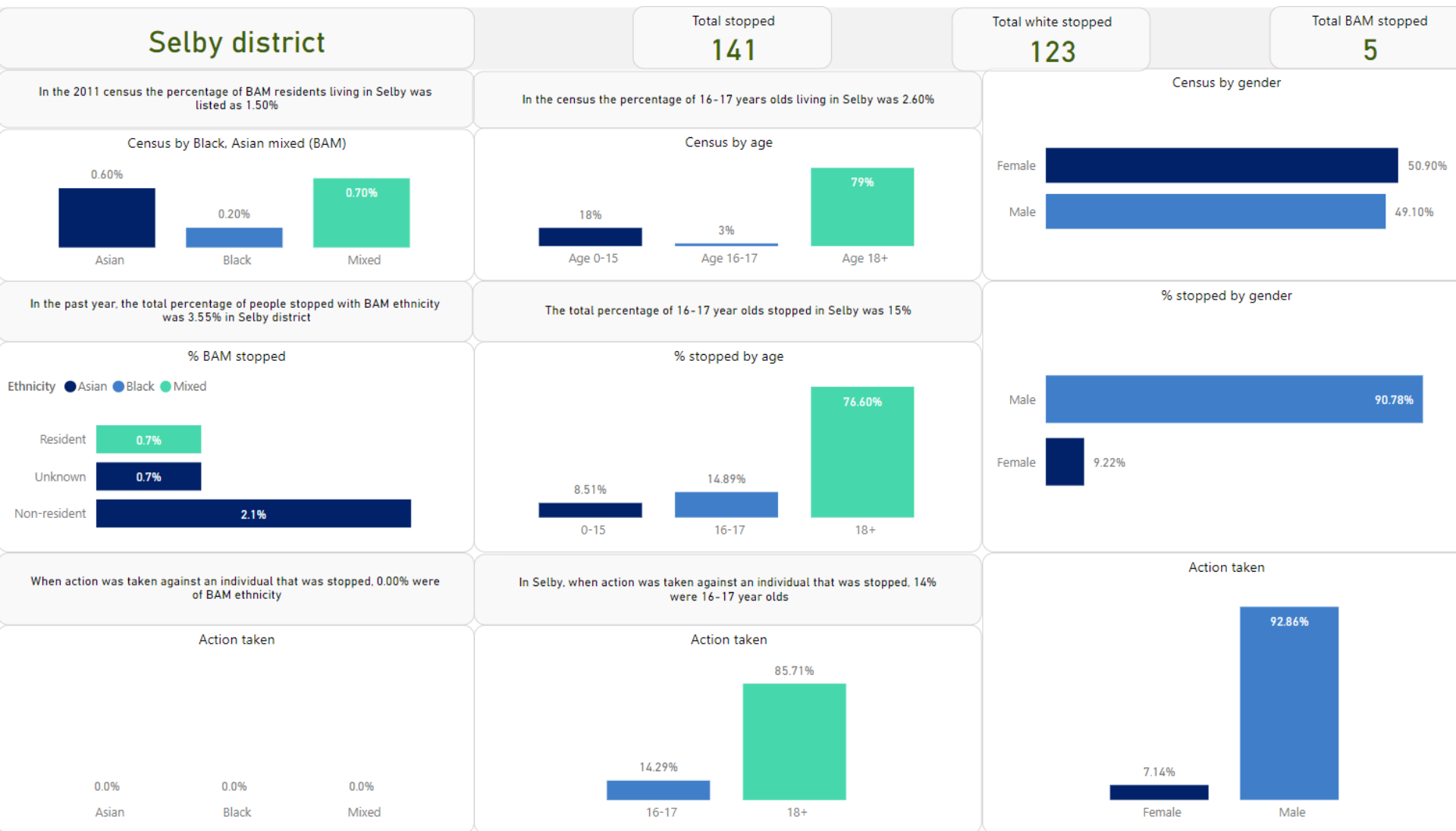

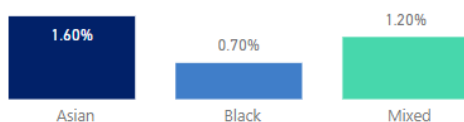

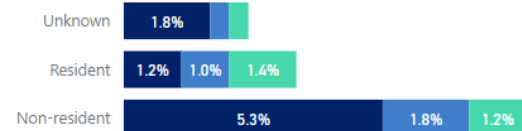

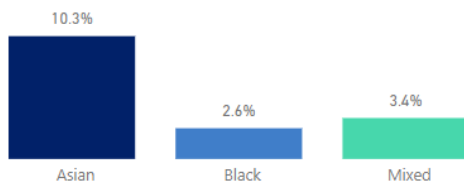

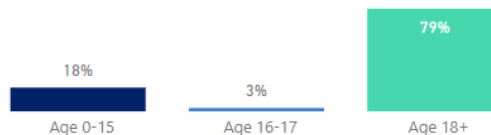

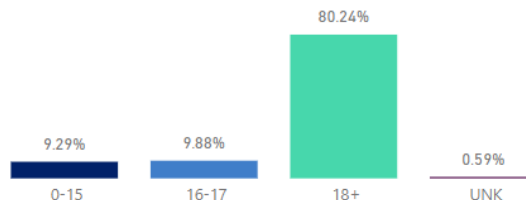

Census by age



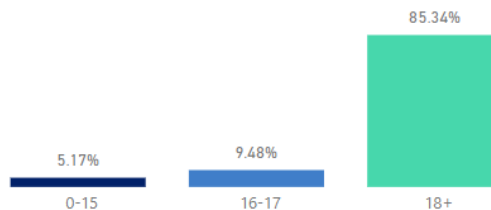

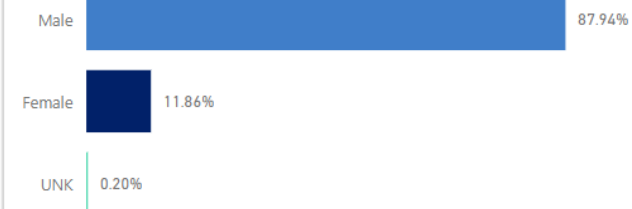

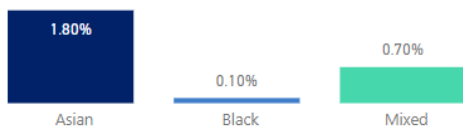

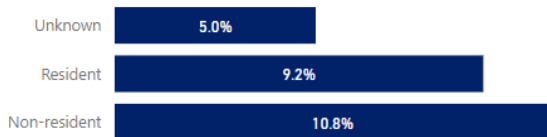
Census by Black, Asian mixed (BAM)

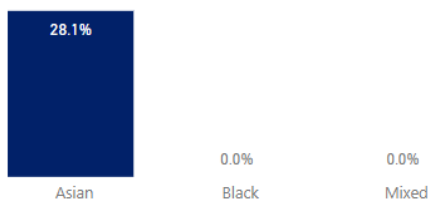

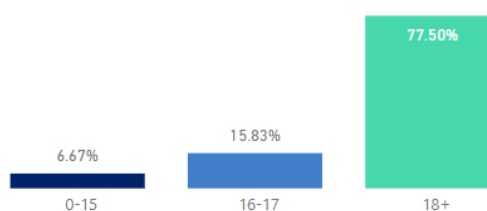

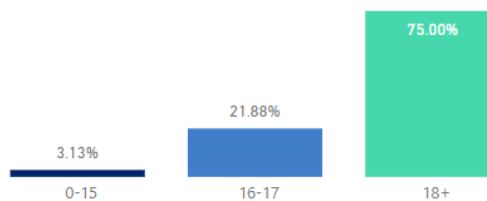

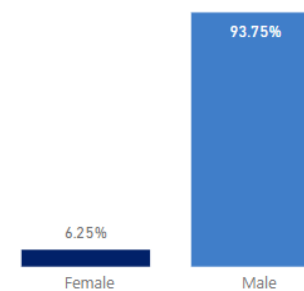

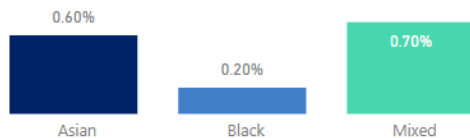

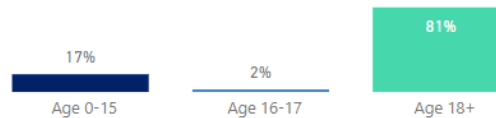

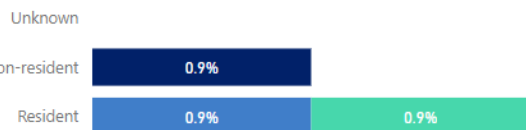

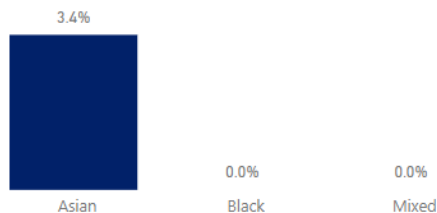

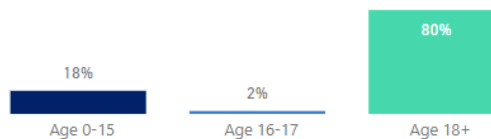

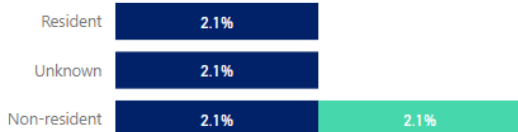

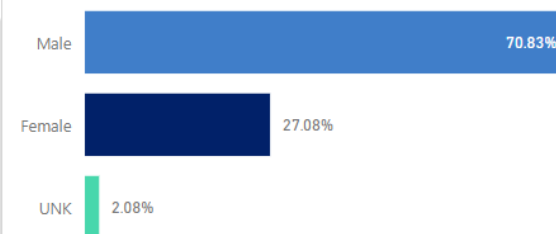

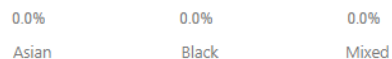

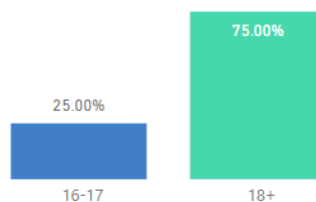

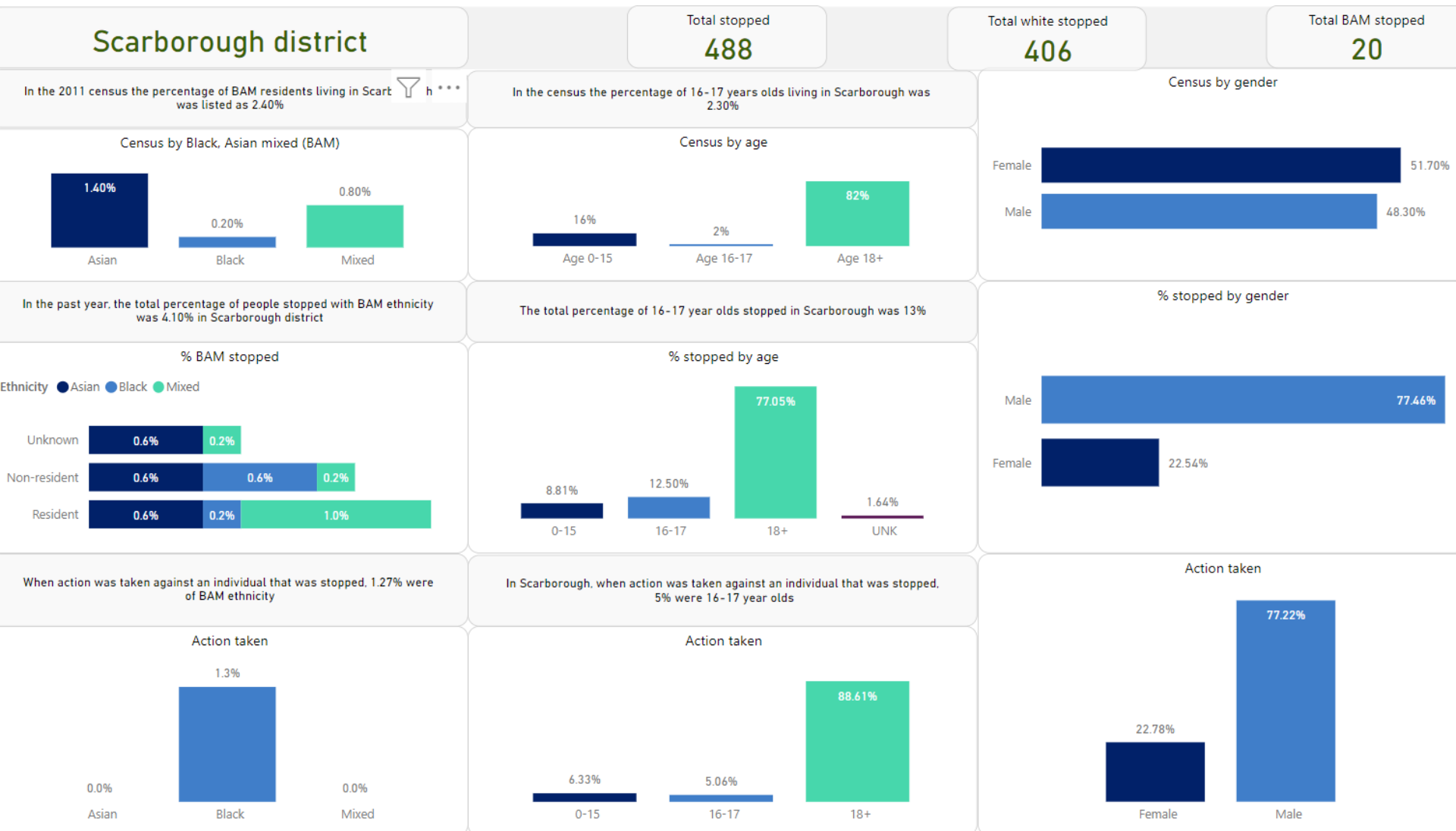

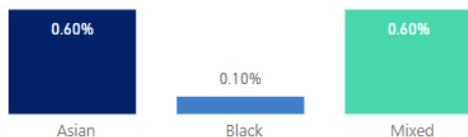

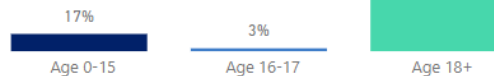

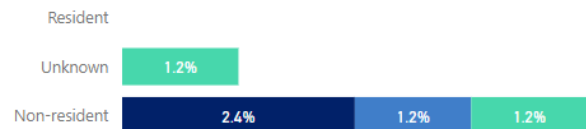

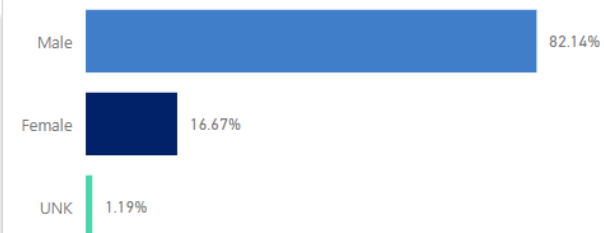


The total percentage of 16-17 year olds stopped in Ryedale was 10%

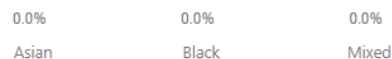

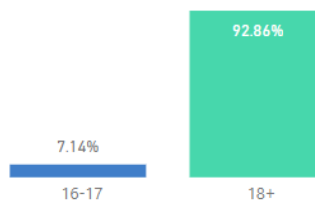
